No Clumping

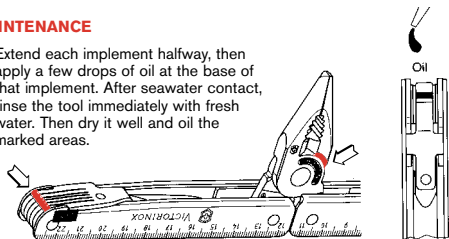
Individual springs hold each tool in place, so you can easily access only the tool you want to use.

Lock and Release

Tools are locked into place when opened. When closed, simply slide the release button and fold the tool away.

MAINTENANCE

Extend each implement halfway, then apply a few drops of oil at the base of that implement. After seawater contact, rinse the tool immediately with fresh water. Then dry it well and oil the marked areas.

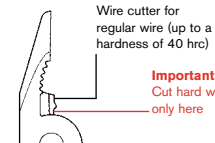
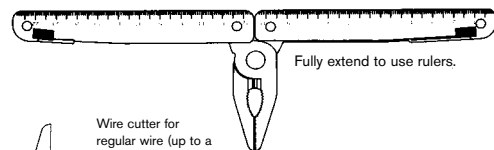
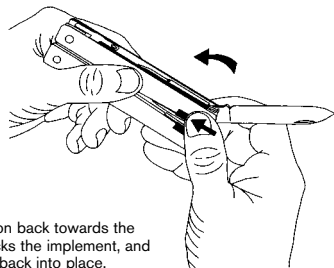
CONVENIENCE AND USE

Be extremely careful when handling and using implements as many have sharp and/or pointed edges. Access plier and wire cutter by opening handles; wire cutter is located at the base of the plier jaws. To close, reverse opening procedure. To open handle implements, grasp implement and pull out slowly until locked in place. To close, release slide mechanism and carefully fold implement back into the handle.

CAUTION

Never use the SwissTool™ implements at 90°; always fully extend and lock implements before use.
